Casula High School's Homework Centre 2023 will begin running this week, Thursday 9th February, in the school library from 3.00pm – 4.30pm.

The aim of the Homework Centre is to provide students with a quiet environment equipped with the latest technology and teacher support in order to best support their educational needs. Casula High School staff (from different faculties) will operate the centre each week in order to best support our students across all their subjects.

The understanding of the Homework centre is that students bring their homework and/or assignments with them. In order to create an environment that facilitates learning, students must follow the homework centre rules.

- Students attending must bring any work that may require assistance. The homework centre is not a facility in which students come to socialise or play games on their iPads.
- In the event the student has no upcoming assessments or homework due, students are expected to be prepared to study and revise key content.
- Any siblings that are waiting for their brother or sister are expected to participate in the Homework Centre and all students must be either picked up or walk home (as indicated on the returned permission note) no later than 4.30pm.
- ALL Casula High School regular rules apply as per normal during the program.
- Failure of students to comply with the centre rules will result in one verbal warning, followed by a letter home and for repeat offenders, possible exclusion from the centre.
