## Mobile Phone Procedures

The NSW Department of Education has developed the Students' Use of Mobile Phones in Schools policy. The Casula High School Mobile Phone Policy will impact the way students will use and access their mobile phones during school hours.

Casula High School has partnered with Yondr Pouches for the implementation of a school-wide consistent practice with all students having received a Yondr pouch..

### Entering School Grounds

- As students enter school grounds they will turn their phones off, unlock their pouch if required, place their phone and listening devices inside the pouch, secure it closed and place into their backpack.
- Students will maintain possession of their mobile phone inside their pouch for the duration of the school day.

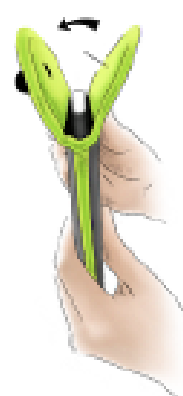
### Exiting School Grounds

- As students exit the school at the end of the day they will unlock their pouch using the unlocking bases. They will remove their phone and listening devices from the pouch. They will then securely close their empty pouch in their backpack ready for the next day.



#### POUCH

As the student enters school, they place their phone in their assigned Yondr pouch.



#### SECURE

The pouch is closed and secured. Each student keeps their pouch throughout the day.



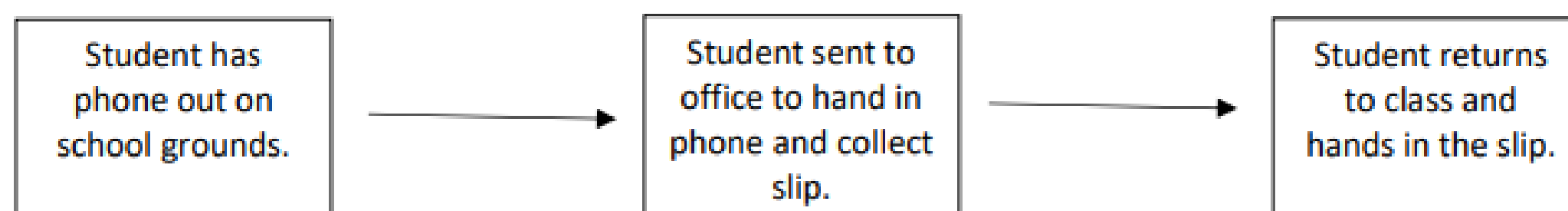
#### EXIT

When leaving school, the student taps their pouch to an unlocking base to release their phone.

### Breaches of the Policy

- Potential breaches of the policy include but is not limited to physical damage to the pouch, losing or forgetting the pouch, using a mobile phone on school grounds, using a smart watch for other purposes other than a traditional watch, using other devices for purposes other than education including using social media, listening to music, filming or texting.

### Process for Phone Misuse



- Persistent phone misuse will result in further consequences such as having their phone confiscated for a period of time, formal cautions or a suspension.
