We are writing this letter to keep you updated with the latest changes regarding Reporting and Parent Teacher Evenings for Semester One at Casula High.

Reporting

We will be providing a simplified written report to parents and carers in Semester 1. Reporting will focus on student's progress achievement, as well as areas of development. Your child has been assessed at school and during the learning from home period. Year 11 and 12 students will receive their semester one report in Term 2 Week 8. Year 7 - 10 students will receive their Semester 1 report in Term 3 Week 2.

Parent Teacher Evening

Year 12 Parent Teacher evening

Year 12 Parent Teacher evening will be held on 23 June, this will be held remotely. Parents will have the opportunity to discuss their child's progress with their teachers by booking through a 10 minute appointment through the parent portal in Millennium. Teachers will contact parents either by phone or through a Zoom session. Further details will follow.

Year 7 – 11 Parent Teacher Evening

Year 7-11 Parent Teacher evening will be held in Term 3 and details will be communicated to families regarding the parent teacher evening format as details come forward from the Department of Education. A tentative date has been booked for 11 August 2020.

Decision Time

Each year Casula High School hosts an information evening to support students in Year 8 and 10 elective subject choices for the following year. This is a compulsory event due to the important information that students need regarding their subject choices but will be slightly different this year and will be held remotely.

Prior to the evening families will receive an information pack regarding subjects on offer and fees associated. All information relating to decision time will be made available through a website which we will communicate to families prior to the event. The senior executive and Head Teachers will be available remotely on the evening to support with questions to allow our students and families to make informed decisions prior to selecting subjects for 2021. We will communicate further information regarding decision time in the following weeks.
